Corrections Corrections is still continuing to take meetings into multiple institutions. The Behind the Walls .US website is still being used to house the policy documents and information about getting cleared for the state and federal institutions. Requests from inmates to work steps are being forwarded to the ISWG (which stands for Inmate Step Working Group) out of the Gold Coast. They have a well developed policy and individuals who are willing to write to inmates but not visit them (as that's a big no-no). The workgroup meets over Zoom on Wednesdays at 8:30PM. FD 1. Autonomy of home groups? Are work groups required?

- Group Conscience rules the group service
- Specific reasons cited for changing things in home group
- There are no requirements from NA World Service

2. Our home group has trespassed a Newcomer for being explosive disruptive and had emergency group

conscience with only 4 people present. Violated the 3rd & 5th traditions?

- The group wasn't out of line in trying to provide an atmosphere of recovery
- The 3rd tradition pertains to NA not the home group
- People choose not to come back to meeting because they are scared
- Damage to church could cause all NA home groups to be out
- If Church says to trespass, is cut and dry

3. Area buying some property for ASC meetings and events

- Members buy property and lease it to home groups so NA's name isn't on it
- NA is non-profit so if you make money you go against that
- Form a 501c3
- Problem using 7th tradition funds for a building
- Board of directors will be personally liable
- Looking for a facility to house the area
- We use 7th tradition money for rent all the time
- The conscience of the Ad-hoc group should decide
- NAWS does not own property they rent
- It may be a good idea to be prudent
- Need to do comparison and contrast / risk vs reward
- Separate corporation but centered around NA traditions
- Having consistent place to meet and saving money
- Difficult to find places for activities & meeting
- If we are just in one building are we really out in community?
- Other non-profits aren't afraid to buy property

4. Bermuda - How to handle facility people trying to dictate? (only have certain, specific people, in the facility)

- H&I guidelines suggest rotation at facilities as to not lock someone in
- Facilities have the right to say who comes into the facility
- Present people to bring in H&I if they refuse then that facility does not get a meeting
- Stop going for a while and see if they change their mind
- Is there a specific entity that can go and speak with them?
- Find another PR member on the island to speak to her and if she still refuses then no meeting in the facility
- An agency can not dictate to NA how NA works
- Bring a liaison to sit down and negotiate. If they don't like some then that is just it.
- Maybe setup a Skype meeting with PR & facility

5. How can we bring events, workshops, etc into institutions? Also, NA games & cards for institutions.
