

# SECRETARY REPORT OCTOBER 2020

**The October 11, 2020 meeting of the ASC opened at 3:32pm with the reading of 12 Traditions, 12 Concepts for Service and the definition of an ASC.**

In **open forum**, it was announced that First Step Residential has been shut down to outsiders until further notice. A meeting list has been printed; groups are urged to check to make sure their information is accurate and if not, please contact Sarah for future corrections.

**Roll** was called. 30 of 41 groups were present and represented.

**Secretary report** of September was read and approved.

The **treasurer** reported a balance of \$5376.24 and the intake from literature was \$1270.00.

The **RCM** reported meeting in Tampa and due to the expense of hosting this meeting, Region has opted to meet virtually until the end of this year. This meeting however, will prevent anyone except officers and RCMs from attending. There is an ongoing investigation regarding theft from the Region, this time from on line sources.

**H&I** reported 6 members in attendance. The questions regarding zoom accounts have been resolved. New panel members are needed and many of the institutions have not yet opened.

Craig announced **PR** outreach has been shut down, but 2 presentations are scheduled for this next month.

**Helpline** reported all phonenumber personnel have been contacted. They are still in need of a co-chair and some new people to answer phones. There is a year clean time requirement to answer phones.

No one from **Rack** was present.

**IT** reported 142 hits per day, updates are continuing regularly. We are off the Florida BLMT for now due to the daily updates. Mike reminded all groups to contact NA.ORG to register their group and meeting information. Currently, monthly cost of meeting lists is \$152.00. He would like groups to consider sublimating using QR Codes which would save \$1,374.00 annually.

Patty, from **Activities** announced the pre-sales of T-shirts has covered the cost of printing. This year, rather than a New Years Eve Ball we will be having a New Year's Day Breakfast from 9-12noon at the Salvation Army on Tuttle with a \$5.00 donation suggested.

Ron our former **O&M** Chair is stepping in to train Lisa, they had 5 members in attendance this month.

**Fresh Start** which meets, Saturdays at 7:30pm will be going physical and virtual at the same time.

A **second roll** was taken and 28 of 41 groups were represented with voting members.

Jeff S was nominated as co-Chair he has 3 ½ years clean has done H&I for 2 years and has the willingness and desire to serve the Area.

Craig nominated Mike K for Co Pr. Mike's clean date is May of 2011. He has the willingness and desire to serve the Area.

Roger S chose to decline his nomination as co-Chair and wishes to be considered for RCM 2. He was subsequently nominated to this position.

Matt brought a motion to the floor to disband the Newsletter. His contention is that few read it and it would be money better spent somewhere else. This needs to be brought to the groups before a decision is made.
